SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...the bottom line is we have made the decision, at this point, to do property tax relief and, from my perspective and I think most of the Appropriations Committee, some of the things that we've taken for granted in this state are going to start to slip per the top up there or others that are on the list that we're going to be facing next year, because it's a lot easier, a lot more fun, to fund new programs than it is to fund the same old humdrum things that we've had as a base for the state for hundreds...hundred, that's a little...hundred-plus years. So I would urge at this point to override the...or to support the Appropriations Committee, override these vetoes and let it go at that. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the motion to override. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1501.) 18 ayes, 30 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The motion to override is not successful. Items for the record. I raise the call.

CLERK: Mr. President, before we proceed, thank you. I have a hearing notice from the Government Committee. Amendments: Senator Bromm, LB 951; Senator Schrock, LB 1234; Senator Wickersham, LB 1138.
