County. There are five counties on the eastern end of the state that are included in Region VI. Because the Douglas County Hospital exists their mental health programs, psych programs, holding beds and the rest have been utilized by people from all across the state. There's a large percentage of the people being served that are not from that five state...that five-county area. We're not complaining. We haven't...well, yeah, we're complaining. We got to admit that. For years, Douglas County taxpayers and Dodge and Washington, Sarpy and Cass County taxpayers have been paying the...the part of that cost that comes from those property tax dollars and we do it because we have the resources and we think it's important that we provide that service as close to home as we possibly can. But it is, in fact, for all intents and purposes, a state institution. All the rest of your counties, every one of you in here, don't really have that kind of a problem at your county level because the state, please understand this and listen, the state takes care of those responsibilities for you. This isn't going to pay the whole tab for Region VI at all. It's going to help pay part of the cost that is rightfully the cost of the state, and it's the kind of cost that won't go away and won't be involved in the kind of argument Senator Wickersham said about breaking the budget. Because I can tell you if I were an old county commissioner, like I was for 20 or so years down there, and we were assuming that debt and responsibility we'd say, what in the world are we doing this for? You know, can't get support. Let's just close her down, then let Health and Human Services and the state worry about where they're going to let these poor souls be served. But you can't do that. You can't forsake these people just because you're the only people in the state that are doing this sort of thing for these kind of folks. It's our responsibility to make sure that these kinds of services continue and we need your help, seriously, in Region VI to help continue and provide for those services. I'm convinced if this money and the funds we're using for the mental health providers isn't successful we're going to lose a lot of beds. Now as far as the...the providers are concerned, the institutions and homes that are all around the state that provide some help for you and for your kids, they are vital, they are important. They have raised millions and millions of dollars of private dollars to help build the buildings, and hopefully with our help they can provide some staffing that they
