several years, if you find it a wise thing to do. So, I think that's essentially where we are, and why don't I leave it open for discussion and questions. I'm sorry you don't have it right in front of you. When you get the amendment, it will show as stricken all the original sections, and we'll have inserted new material. But most of the material is not really new, it's picking up what was in the bill originally, plus what was amended onto it on General File. The actual new material is really not all that much, but it does point us in the directions that I described. Thank you.
