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direction we were going. So I certainly would have supported that as well. But I do have some questions for Senator Bohlke if she would yield, please.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Senator Bohlke, we have come so far from where we were originally with the green copy in our discussions last year. I think that you have done excellent work here and I know that when we talked about the NAEP test last year one of the concerns we had was the fact that those were not really valuable to the teacher themselves because they didn't have any results in their hand on individual students. And on your bullet sheet on the back side, it says the assessment and reporting plan shall provide for the confidentiality of the individual students. Now I'm assuming that that means for reporting purposes to the state. Would that also include the teacher or would the teacher have the results so that the teacher could use those to help the student improve their individual learning?

SENATOR BOHLKE: The teacher would get...you're correct, Senator Redfield. The teacher would have the result. We just don't report individual results to the state.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you. I think to me that is one of the most valuable things of what has happened here because this is something that not only allows for accountability to the public but it also allows the teacher to see exactly where that student needs help, where they excel, where they can spend their time wisely within the classroom. We don't want teachers to spend a lot of time on subject areas or specific areas where their entire class is exceeding already. We want them to spend their time where the students need their improvement. And this will allow the teachers to identify those areas and spend the time and improve the learning exactly where their own students need it. So I think this is a tremendous improvement over where we were with the original green copy. I do have one other question for Senator Bohlke, and that is in the comparison about other states, I assume that would continue with our national
