concerned about the, quote, amount of money that's being spent for lobbying, not realizing that really most of the money is spent on members of the association and very little of it is actually spent on members of the Legislature. That's just kind of a perception problem. Maybe the amendment will help us in that area. Maybe it will give flexibility or guidance to the principles and the lobbyists so they'll sort out the costs that really do look like lobbying costs from the costs that don't look like lobbying costs and we'll see a more realistic number appear in their reports and people will actually get a better idea of how much is truly spent for lobbying as opposed to how much is spent for other things but gets reported as lobbying because nobody knows how else to report it. Kind of a confusing state of affairs, both for the people involved, for the people who like to look at the reports and for us who really have nothing to do with the reports at all, but then it creates a perception that somehow very large amounts of money are spent on...
