SENATOR CUDABACK: Good afternoon, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Senators, we're about to reconvene, please check in.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, first agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, when the Legislature recessed for lunch they were discussing LB 1021, a bill by Senator Chambers. Committee amendments have been offered; amendments to those have been adopted...offered and adopted. Senator Beutler had pending AM3227 as an amendment to the committee amendments. Senator, I understand that you'd like to withdraw AM3227 and offer, as an alternative, AM3281.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no objection, so ordered. Senator Beutler, to open on AM3281. (Legislative Journal page 1553.)
