tickets to events or football games or whatever, that those have to be reported. I think we've done some very good things here today, some good work here today. I would certainly be willing to work with others on the amendments that have been offered and pulled here because they've raised some other issues that need to be discussed so that there aren't unintended consequences by a quick adoption here on the floor today. With that, I would simply urge the adoption of the committee amendments and once again thank you for your attention.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. You've heard the closing on the committee amendments. The question before the body is, shall the committee amendments be adopted to LB 1021? All those in favor of the question vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted. We're now open for discussion on the advancement of LB 1021 to E & R Initial. Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, as a result of this debate today, I think there's a couple of observations that I have that I want to share with you that I plan to do. One observation, Senator Schimek, I don't know who would be best suited to do this, whether it's you, Senator Chambers, Senator Wickersham. I think there's been a sufficient number of issues raised today that the need for a white copy, before debate on Select File, is absolutely crucial, written in English so I can understand it. If you can write it in English so I can understand, the other 48 easily ought to be able to understand it. But it is difficult; I know there's a number of members who are saying I got lost two hours ago when we were talking about this statement, that statement, this definition, that definition. That is not uncommon. That will happen when you deal with this area. So a white copy, I think, is crucial with a good explanation of where we're at, because if we can get to that anchor point then other changes will be easier to understand as we go ahead. The second point, observation I have is that I think there is some need, and I
