CLERK: (Read LB 480A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1579.) 28 ayes, 8 nays, 9 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. Pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8, the question is, shall LB 414 be considered for a vote without an at-large reading? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is agreed to. Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

CLERK: (Read LB 414 by title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1580.) 25 ayes, 19 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
