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was the threshold. And now we are going to use the numbers to drive the decision-making and then if those numbers change it could throw off whether that unit could be located where it is. That is not good management. It is very different than Senator Matzke's where it was the threshold for receiving assistance based on the number of jobs. This is the number of jobs determining the location. And I just...I just think that we have to allow those people that we are going to be holding accountable, namely, the State Treasurer, in this instance, to do the management that he needs to do to make this thing work, and that's all I care about is making it work. And I will say that, you know, every body wants to beat their chest and say how mean it is for the...that the federal government is telling us what to do. Well, the federal government has been working with us. They have been providing funds because...because they, in partnership, want to see more child support collected. That is good for the taxpayers of the state of Nebraska, but it is better for the children of the state of Nebraska, and we have consistently increased the amount of child support we have collected because we have worked in partnership with the federal government. And so, you know, please go back to why...what we...why are we making the decision that we are making here. We are making the decision we are making, first of all, because we want it to work, we want it to work for the children of the state of Nebraska, and I think if anybody...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR BROWN: ...needs to prove that this is not going to be detrimental to the process, it needs to be the people who are promoting this particular amendment because, otherwise, there is no reason for us to impose on the Treasurer a management practice that he could determine could be detrimental to the operations of his unit and the success of his unit. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Brown. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members of the body. I want to stand up in strong support of Senator Bourne's amendment. I think he hit something that's really going to help a lot of the people out in our area, and I commend him for doing that, an urban senator doing that. But I guess,
