Well, I'm given the opportunity today to cut away some of that giveaway legislation. These companies still have LB 775 and if we go on long enough with this discussion I don't know what kind of votes I can get in favor of a single amendment that I'm going to offer, but it might be a good time to explore whether or not my colleagues are of a mind to repeal provisions of LB 775 also. That ties in with the subject matter of this bill, which is becoming primarily a repealer. And I don't have the statutory references at my fingertips that embrace the terms of LB 775, but I will be able to find them, or somebody I can put up to finding them for me, and offer repealers of LB 775. And if we got some suggestive votes on the possibility of repealing that legislation that might be a way to give a message to these big shots and the fat pockets. But here's...
