SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Schrock, on the committee amendment.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I overheard the fact that Becton-Dickinson was mentioned as a recipient of the Quality Jobs Act and just like to report to you that it's an important employer in Holdrege, Nebraska, employing about 650 people, quality jobs, good benefits, and this new round they'll probably get about 30 more jobs there. It's important to communities like Holdrege. It's the main employ...it's the main employer. And so, from that standpoint, I'd just like to add my two cents in favor of the LB 1330. So...and you may be interested in knowing that what they produce there is hypodermic needles. They are the world's largest producer of disposable insulin syringes, so...right there in Holdrege, Nebraska, and they are an important employer in that area of the state. Thank you.
