Then, finally, the whole act would be sunsetted. Then, finally, the who act would be sunsetted February 1st of 1967--that's what it says--if no applications have been approved prior to that time. The same is true on LB 829. It has the same kind of limitations, but that is the effect of the amendment and what time might be left I would like to give to Senator Withem, who may want to explain the act overall as well before we vote on the committee amendments. Senator Crosby: thank you. Senator Warner, you...Senator Withem, you have about three and a half minutes. Senator Withem: yeah, I really don't need that. Just as is customary in a fairly complicated major bill like this when the committee makes some substantive amendments, I don't think these are major amendments in that they don't change the thrust of the bill. It's customary for the introducer of the bill to comment on those amendments, and I see absolutely nothing in these amendments that does not move toward making this a better bill, and for that reason, I would urge the members of the Legis...of the body to adopt the committee amendments. Senator Crosby: thank you, Senator Withem. For discussion on the committee amendment, Senator Warner, your light is the first light. Senator Wesely. Senator Schimek on the amendments. Senator Schimek: yes, Madam President. Senator Warner, I just have one question, and I don't understand what number seven on the summary of the committee amendments means. Now if that's all she didn't understand, she understood a lot more than I did. It says annexation of a project shall not extend the zoning jurisdiction of the annexing city. You can annex this property but you don't have zoning jurisdiction over it, then? Senator Warner: yes, under the provisions of...of the act for redevelopment for the work...the site, say it was a section of land would be annexed into the city, but it would not be contiguous as is otherwise required, so it's special permission to annex, but what the purpose of the amendment is is that we make sure that if it was a first class city they have a mile jurisdiction, that they didn't automatically pick up another mile around that, or if it was Lincoln or Omaha, it would be three miles around, and the idea is that the entity that currently has that zoning jurisdiction could continue to retain it whether it was a county or another municipality unless they
