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going to sell off some of this land and we're going to get down to a different percentage. I know that's going to happen. I'm not disputing that. I'm not trying to backtrack on that. Mine is how you do it. And I know that there is some anxious, for some reason or other, there's a great anxiousness to move the bill along. I don't plan to offer any other amendments, Senator Baker. But I think it is not accurate to state that this can't work. It can. You may not like what it does, and that's a legitimate disagreement. I do think, though, that there were some other issues out here that as long as we've got some time on this amendment that are applicable to bring up. One of them is that you've got one group managing the land. You've got another group managing the funds and the investments. They're not talking to each other. Would it be better if you owned, if you were the state of Nebraska and you owned all the investments, you probably would put them in one place...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...where you could have a mix of funds and you could be a good broker, but that's not the system we have. We have a constitutional system of one group on one hand, we have investments on the other, and we're having to struggle with that right now. And that's the purpose of the amendment. I still think the amendment works. I know it will be uncomfortable, but I think it protects the best land so it's not sold off first. And I'd yield my time back. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. We're discussing the Kristensen amendment, AM3231. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. And I think I want to be up front about this. When my amendment to Senator Kristensen's amendment was adopted, Senator Chambers asked me if I would support the amendment and I said I would. And I sat in on the meeting with Rex Holsapple about how this would work or not work, and following that I became concerned about the workability and went and talked to Senator Kristensen this morning. He was gracious enough to say when you have a chance to get new information and if you look at something differently after getting that information, I'm going to be...I'm going to release you from that representation you made that you would
