CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We're opening discussion on the advancement of LB 1010 to E & R for engrossing. Seeing no lights on, Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1010 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a machine vote. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 1010 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the advancement of LB 1010 to E & R for engrossing. Have you all voted who care to?

SENATOR BAKER: I'd like to ask for a roll call vote, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a roll call vote on advancement of LB 1010 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR BAKER: Call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

SENATOR BAKER: Are we still under call? I'd ask to call the house, then.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the chamber. The house is under call. Senator Robak, please check in. All present or accounted for. Mr. Clerk, call the roll, please.
