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existing council is concerned better than you can. In fact, I suspect you can do it much better than I can. But it has been a council that...let me put it this way. Given the difficulty of dealing with land issues in any area, and in that particular area has done extremely well in terms of trying to get a grasp on the job and they've gone so far as to hire a director. They've begun some initial kinds of facility functions, like setting out garbage disposal sites and bathroom facilities, that sort of thing. They have a small budget. You may recall we gave them about \$25,000, I think, last year. They have functioned well together even though it involves a broad cross-section of people. The...where they've run into problems is that it was envisioned that all of the counties would have zoning and that the zoning would be appropriate and, right now, there's still one of the four counties that doesn't have zoning. The others have zoning. I think they're moving along as well as could be expected. Senator Dierks, I'm going to stop there and ask if there's particular aspects of their development that you are interested in or maybe you wanted to recite.

SENATOR DIERKS: No, I...there was a court decision I think, and maybe I could ask Senator Jones to go into that a little bit. Are you familiar with the court decision?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Are you talking about the federal decision?

SENATOR DIERKS: Yeah.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah, I can talk about that a little bit.

SENATOR DIERKS: Okay. I think that should be on our record, if we can.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. The court decision that Senator Dierks is talking about is a case called National Park and Conservation Association v. Stanton (phonetic) and, oversimplifying quite a bit, that case was brought, as I had indicated to you earlier, by some national environmental groups and some national...I guess you would call them national park oversight citizen groups. They get involved in a lot of park...park cases and keep an eye on what's going on in the parks from a conservation, environmental point of view. And they brought this case against
