Those in favor say aye. Those opposed...those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is successful. Senator Bromm, you're recognized to open on AM3018.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Lieutenant Governor. And the opening or the statement I gave with respect to the motion really is a summary of what AM3018 does, and so I would stand on that information and again yield to questions, if there would be any. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Debate on AM3018 to LB 1004? Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close. Senator Bromm waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM3018 to LB 1004. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1004 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LB 1004 to E & R for engrossment. Those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 1401.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1401. Senator Beutler would move to return the bill for specific amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Sen...there was another motion filed on LB 1004. We will return to LB 1004 for a motion to return. Mr. Clerk.
