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there was nothing left, except a little puff of smoke, all of these are working on behalf of Daddy Warbucks. And there is sympathy extended toward Daddy Warbucks because, to borrow from Senator Bourne, he's merely a pig now, but he wants to be a hog; he needs more. Just like hell, as the Bible said, it's bound..its borders are never full, it's always open for more; welcome, welcome. Give to those who already have and take from those who don't have. So here's poor Little Orphan Annie, one A-line dress, that's all Little Orphan Annie ever had in the whole time she existed, one little red A-line dress, all she had to her name, and she always was an orphan; nobody ever determined that she had parents, and, if she did, who her parents were. Maybe the only time she got a break was when she went on Broadway, and if she got any residuals, she might be able to kind of capitalize now. But for all those years, prior to her going on Broadway with "Annie", she was poor. So now we come to this bill, the Daddy Warbucks bill, and there will be great crocodile tears shed on behalf of Daddy Warbucks. Give to these poor, struggling television stations who are going to be required to assume the responsibilities of citizenship in the same way that everybody else must assume those responsibilities. People who, if they had a voice, would not have to pay a disproportionate share of the costs of government; but, since they have no voice, they are there for the picking, then they will be taken advantage of. It would be very difficult if you weighed this bill against some of the vetoes that have already been sustained to justify enacting this bill. And the Governor will probably sign it, if you send it over there, because he is one of the greatest actors I've seen. How much time do I have, Mr. President?

SENATOR CUDABACK: You have about two minutes, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thanks, I think I can get it in. Something that offended me the other day was him calling a press conference to exploit a situation involving his son. You know why he called that press conference? Not because he cared about that boy, but to keep people from saying, Johans is responsible for his depression. He brought in the young man's wife, mentioned her by name, said they're having marital difficulties; she has made him so depressed that he is suicidal. It spread all of their business out before the whole world, and then, when
