SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, I think the amendment has been explained as best it can be explained, and I'm glad that it's agreeable to Senator Landis. I think it will help a little bit. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Beutler. The question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to AM3130 to LB 932. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Voting on the Beutler amendment. Madam Clerk, please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment to the Landis amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to. Madam Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend. (FA399, Legislative Journal page 1635.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature, I got one word wrong in the amendment that we just passed. Nothing changes in the intent, but I screwed up one word. I need to change it from...so we're going from "custodial trustee" to "custodial official". Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Beutler, would you like to close? Senator Beutler waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to the Landis amendment to LB 932. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to. Debate on the Landis amendment? Senator Kiel.
