SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator. Senator Beutler, Bohlke, and Senator Bourne. Senator Brown, please check in. The house is under call. Senators Matzke and Dwite Pedersen. Senator Dickey and Dierks. Senators Kiel and Kremer. Senator Kiel, would you please check in. Thank you. Senator Schrock and Senator Suttle. The house is under call. Senator Chambers. All unexcused senators, the house is under call. Senator Beutler, Senator Brown, Senator Matzke, and Senator Schrock. Senator Chambers, Senator Dierks, Senator Kremer. Senator Schrock, the house is under call. Please report to the Chamber. Senator Brown. Senator Beutler, would you please check in. Thank you. Senator Matzke, would you please check in. Thank you. Mr. Clerk, all present or accounted for and there has been a request for a roll call vote in reverse order. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Wickersham amendment to the Landis amendment was not adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item. I do raise the call.

CLERK: Senator Wickersham, AM3333. (Legislative Journal page 1641.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wickersham, to open on AM3333.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Mr. President. This is an amendment that concerns the scope of the cost that would be eligible for the credit. Senator Landis spoke briefly about this amendment in his opening to AM3330. The amendment that I'm offering you is somewhat narrower than what Senator Landis is proposing. If you read what he is proposing on page 11 and 12 of the amendment, you'll see that in part Senator Landis wants folks to receive credit for fencing, for landscaping, for sidewalks, amongst other things. The amendment that I'm offering you would say, okay, you can have credit for the materials, the supplies, the food, and the equipment. Now that's a little bit broader than construction paper that Senator Landis suggested in his opening, but it doesn't include fencing, landscaping, sidewalks, that's true. Now it also makes a change
