quality. It's important that you have a building that the roof won't fall in, that there is plumbing and those sorts of things. Licensure deals with those sorts of issues and some others, to be fair, but in terms of putting demands on employees to be well trained and hopefully well paid to offer a sound curriculum, there is very little offered with the licensure requirement. To comment on another item or two, Senator Crosby mentioned, well, why don't we go ahead with the Landis program and, if it doesn't work, we'll come back and maybe increase the requirements. I would caution you against that. Tax credit programs tend to become recognized as entitlements and trying at some later date to increase the requirement to receive that entitlement is a very, very difficult task. So I hope that we'll have some discussion on this amendment. I think it is an important addition. In my case I could support the bill with this sort of an amendment. I don't think I can without it, so I would urge your adoption. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. You've heard the opening on AM3338 to the Landis amendment. Those wishing to discuss are Senators Chambers, Landis, Brown and Suttle. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm not going to get into this debate, but I will say that with the rejection of Senator Wickersham's last amendment I'm not going to support the amendment and I'm not going to support the bill. I think when I look at all of these things that these businesses are being given, the bill is turning into something entirely different from what I thought it would be. When they talk about fencing...let me ask Senator Landis a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, would you respond, please?

SENATOR LANDIS: Um-hum.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Landis, if ConAgra was going to put a child-care facility in place on their campus, how much of their campus could be fenced under this wording in your amendment now?

SENATOR LANDIS: Only that portion for which was used for a child-care facility.
