true; a tax credit, however, this is the only one. Don't allow the perfect to be the enemy of the good. There's good things in here to cut down the cost of childcare. As a matter of fact, Senator...the Governor attacked how much childcare had grown, the costs. This...the Hilgert amendment cuts it by \$1.5 million. I think it does essentially the idea of putting kids and mothers together, and that's a pretty darn good idea, and the idea of telling companies, if you spend a dollar for childcare, we will reward you as differently and better than if you spend a dollar for a truck. And I don't think there's much wrong with that idea as well, particularly since we will up the ante if they spend it for quality childcare as well. I ask for the adoption of the amendment and then the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Landis. You've heard the closing on AM3330 to LB 925. All in favor of the amend...of that amendment being adopted vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the Landis amendment to LB 925. Have you all voted? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Landis' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Landis amendment was adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wickersham, AM3240, I had a note you wanted to withdraw that.

SENATOR CUDABACK: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: And Senator Hilgert, a similar amendment, you wanted...AM3309, you wanted to withdraw, Senator?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Are...

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is the advancement. Is there any further discussion on the advancement of LB 925 to E & R for engrossing? Senator Chambers.
