SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Redfield.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. At the request of Senator Jensen, I would withdraw my amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have, Senator Jensen, AM2933. Have a note you want to withdraw that, Senator.

SENATOR JENSEN: That is correct.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Senator Hilgert, AM2987. (AM2987, Legislative Journal page 1228.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hilgert.

SENATOR HILGERT: Thank you. I'm sorry for this. I do want to talk to Senator Jensen briefly, so my opening, can we start the clock running on the amendment so I can discuss something? You can start my time rolling.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Why don't...would you wish to pass over your amendment, put it at the bottom, Senator Hilgert?

SENATOR HILGERT: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: So ordered. Mr. Clerk, next item to the bill.

CLERK: Senator Suttle, AM2875. (AM2875, Legislative Journal page 1093.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Suttle. Anybody here authorized to handle Senator Suttle's? We'll pass over the Suttle amendment.

CLERK: Senator Byars, AM3027.
