SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars.

SENATOR BYARS: Withdraw.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Suttle and others, AM2525. (AM2525, Legislative Journal page 1084.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Suttle. Anybody here authorized to withdraw the amendment or take it up or whatever? Pass over it.

CLERK: Senator Brashear, AM2916.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, I'd ask leave to withdraw the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Senator Dierks, AM2943.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Please withdraw both, the next two amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Both amendments are withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, the next item.

CLERK: Senator Dierks, that applies to AM2953, Senator, right? Thank you. Senator Kiel, AM3043. (AM3043, Legislative Journal page 1254.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kiel.

SENATOR KIEL: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. My amendment would provide for provisional licensing for speech pathologists and audiologists.
