CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Bromm amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Next amendment, Senator Thompson, AM3076.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Thompson.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Because that amendment passed, there's no need for this amendment and I withdraw it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Senator Hartnett, AM3054.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, I would withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item to the bill.

CLERK: Senator Engel, AM3059.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Engel.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. President, I withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: That amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item to the bill.

CLERK: Senator Suttle, AM2875, but I have a note, withdraw?

SENATOR SUTTLE: Withdraw, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.
