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necessarily bad policy. I'm just trying to ferret out what...what was reportable and what was not. The individual tickets, I guess I'm going to have to sit and think a little bit whether that's good policy because...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time. Debate on the Brashear amendment to the Schimek amendment to LB 1021? Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, I'd move to recess until 1:30 this afternoon.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is, shall we recess until 1:30? Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. We are recessed.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good afternoon. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Senators, please check in, we're about to reconvene. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, first item.

CLERK: Mr. President, when the Legislature recessed, Senator Schimek had pending AM3321 to the bill. Senator Brashear had offered AM3347. Senator Brashear, I understand you'd like to withdraw AM3347 and offer as a substitute AM3365.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Mr. Clerk, I would.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no objections, so ordered. Senator Brashear, to open on your amendment. (AM3365, Legislative Journal page 1673.)
