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vehicle requirement for certain alfalfa harvesting equipment, which was...again, we didn't have anybody in lobbying for this, but through work of members on the committee, it seemed like that these changes made sense. So I would ask for your support for these two amendments to LB 1361. It's all actually rolled into one amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. You've heard the opening on the Bromm amendment, AM3328, to LB 1361. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. Thank you, Senator Bromm, for bringing these bills to us and putting them...amending them into LB 1361. A few years ago, I carried a bill for some people in my district who had these large cranes. At that time, the Department of Roads had no problem with issuing the permits for those cranes to use the roads and...after they got their permit, of course. But it was time consuming for the Department of Roads in the issuing of permits. They were never denied. And it was time consuming for the people who owned those cranes, because there were times when they could have been on the job and they were busy filling out paperwork, trying to get the permit. So this is going to be a lot better for those people. They don't know exactly, a lot of times, when their job is going to be complete. And before they can move that piece of equipment, they have to apply for another permit, because the time has run out on that permit. This is going to be very helpful, especially with the amount of construction and so on that we've got going in this state now. And by us keeping those...the statutes the way they are, was hampering the people's ability not only to get their jobs done, but also make enough money to pay for the cranes. These pieces of equipment are very, very expensive, and they have to keep them on the job continually or the banker is going to be on their neck also. So thank you for bringing this bill and amending it in. It will be much appreciated by some particular people in my district. With that, thank you, and I hope...ask you to give your support to the amendments to LB 1361. Thank you.
