CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Motion is agreed to. Senator Bromm, you're recognized to open on AM3364. (Legislative Journal page 1688.)

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Lieutenant Governor. The only thing I would add to that is that on the part of the amendment that I mentioned, the lump sum on the "respin" amount being paid in September, that a district would have to apply for that. They're not going to get it in lump sum unless they apply for that to the Department of Education. And so I wanted to clarify that. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Debate on the Bromm amendment to LB 1213? Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close. Senator Bromm waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM3364 to LB 1213. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Voting on the Bromm amendment. Mr. Clerk, please record.
