PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time. Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Question.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Do I see five hands? I see five hands. The question is, shall debate cease? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Voting on the motion to end debate. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Lynch, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members, Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members, this won't take long. It's been a long day. I think there is probably more illegal gambling going on in Nebraska than there is legal gambling and it's in all kinds of forms and I think you know that as well as I. But there are a number of things that concern me about the particular part of this bill, for example, that deals with pickles. And that is that the only place a machine, and that's what this bill is all about as it applies to pickles, the only place a machine can be is in an established place of business where they have a legitimate liquor license. That's all. You got to be 21 to drink. And I think any sensible operator would not allow machines in their place where they have that liquor license and then allow 18-year-olds in just so they could play the machines. It's...it would be a dangerous thing indeed, and they have a terrible price to pay if in fact they allow teenagers to participate in any kind of gambling in their liquor establishment or restaurant or wherever else it might be. Just like Jim Jensen, I've been in places, I've been in Kwik Shops and stores and grocery stores where they have pickle cards. I...doesn't mean you have to play them, of course, but the fact that they're there might be a temptation, but I'd like to think
