CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 659 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LB 659 to E & R. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: After the A bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 659A, Senator Smith, I have AM2743, but I have a note you want to withdraw that, Senator.

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Smith would move to amend with AM3373. (Legislative Journal page 1695.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, this is the sufficient A bill to adjust the figures associated with the costs of this bill that do not involve cash..or do not...or does not involve General Funds but strictly Cash Funds. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Smith. Debate on the Smith amendment to LB 659A. Senator Smith, you're recognized to close. Senator Smith waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM3373 to LB 659A. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Smith's amendment.
