PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. LB 1003A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1003A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1710-1711.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. LB 1004. Pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8, the question is, shall LB 1004 be considered for a vote without an at-large reading? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 41 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to dispense with Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is agreed to. Madam Clerk, please read the title.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1004 by title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1711.) The vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. LB 1008.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1008 on Final Reading.)
