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been, for the last four years, been told each year, wait another year and we'll have a plan in place. But I really...I really would like that plan to be more comprehensive. I don't think that LB 652 adequately addresses the gatekeeper piece that was recommended by the study that was done. And so it's not just about whether or not we have the money and that, I think is a very critical piece, but it is, does this get us to where we need to be in terms of the plan, in terms of the partnership that I believe there has to be between the county and the state in terms of the provision of services to juveniles? And the only thing that comforts me a little bit is that we did build into the budget all the...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR HUDKINS: ...deficit requests from Medicaid that came forward and we did override for the reimbursement rate for those services that we need...some of the services that we need to have in place, we need to have more of them. And so if we do not override on LB 652, I think we need to be absolutely committed to having some comprehensive resolution of this issue, based on the plan that was done, based on the research that was done. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President, members, I'll be very brief. I just wanted to remind the body that we did do, two years ago or last year, \$6.8 million taking over county jail costs. So we have been putting additional money into counties. I know it's never enough and that is kind the way a lot of these things go. But I just wanted to remind the body that we have been doing some things along that line in addition to some counties that have gained from taking over the assessors jobs and things like that. So we've been doing some other things for co...and we're also doing some things now with property tax relief going back in another form. But I think there are several things going on that are being done for county property tax relief across the board, and that ought not to be forgotten as we do this. And, once again, I oppose the override motion.
