So, if the...if this bill is overridden, I will be submitted LB 480A for also an override, because I believe it would be the responsible thing to do, to carry out the functions that are intended in this bill, which does include the...the Advisory Council and some things like that, that I believe will need to be funded. I appreciate the women's cash initia...Women's Initiative Cash Fund, it is going to be part of that. But, beyond that, the executive director and some other things I believe should be adequately funded if this was to pass.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Suttle.

SENATOR SUTTLE: Thank you, Mr. President. I think that the fact that there's no money in this, notwithstanding what Senator Wehrbein has said, that he thinks there ought to be if it passes, I don't understand any of this, this year. We have money that appears from nowhere, we don't fund things that we should fund, we fund things that we shouldn't fund and we fund things in different departments that can take care of things that we already have, whatever any of that all means. But this, apparently, is...is...is being addressed in the department. Well then, what's wrong with having a commission to help them raise private funds? I don't get it, except that it's a women's issue. Women and children first in this body off the budget. I would urge you to override this veto. It is something that we should do. Look to your conscience. One thing, 49 of us must have enough backbone together to buck one man out in the lobby, out in the Rotunda, and I don't believe that's the Governor. I would appreciate it if you would override this. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Wehrbein, I would like to respectfully disagree with you and ask you a question or two, if I might.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.
