So for your planning purposes, that would occur in that area. If we get done with Final Reading, if we get done with the LR 499 resolution prior to 2:30, we'll just move through the agenda. There was a little confusion yesterday. We'll break our usual from noon to 1:30 for lunch. We'll come back, and if we're not completed, we'll move to the confirmation reports at 2:30 and try to get through the agenda. I think we ought to be able to do everything today. Based on comments made last night, LB 1361 should be removed from the agenda. Well, Senator Bromm isn't here. He wouldn't get it anyway. It will still be read. Thank you, Mr. President.
