Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed with the emergency
clause attached. Mr. Clerk...Madam Clerk, LB 972A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 972A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure
having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass?
Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal
page 1756.) The vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present not voting,
1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. (Visitors introduced.)
Mr. Clerk, LB 1021.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bruning would move to bracket the
bill until April 12th.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bruning, you're recognized to open
on your motion to bracket LB 1021.

SENATOR BRUNING: (Recorder malfunction) ...for discussion
purposes, although I'm concerned, as well, enough with the bill
that I may just vote against it. You know, as I thought about
this bill a little bit and I thought about my own life, one of
the things that concerned me is, I've got friend, his name is
Scott Miller, lives down in Nebraska City. I've been friends
with him...met him in college, and he's been a buddy of mine
since we met in '87. We both like to golf. And one of the
things we've tried to do every now and then is head down to
