must do as Speaker, and that I've observed other Speakers do, is be somewhat flexible and adapt as we go to do what we need to do to accomplish the work that lies ahead of us. Media will say, well, how do you expect to do this in 90 days, and my response is we will do it just like we've done it in the past. And we've had tough issues in the past and this Legislature and people in this Chamber have faced some very tough times in the past. Not all of us were there when those times were here, but we will do what we need to do. And I'm very encouraged and very positive about serving as Speaker, if I'm given that opportunity. The work ethic of this group that I have seen is, in my opinion, at a very high level compared to many groups that I have been a part of. I stopped in here Sunday for a few minutes to pick up some things and deliver some things and I saw lights on in the Fiscal Office, and there were people in there working. Now they don't get paid extra for that and you all don't get paid extra for all that you do, but I recognize that we have great support around here. We have great staff and, with that in mind, I'm more than willing to take on the task and I will do the best that I can, calling on the experience that I've had in the ten years and also the two special sessions. I thank you for the opportunity and I would call it a privilege, if elected, to serve you as Speaker of this Ninety-Eighth Legislature. Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor.
