Chair of the Enrollment and Review Committee by acclamation. All those in favor please say aye. All those opposed say nay. Congratulations, Senator Mossey. Pursuant to the provisions of Article IV, Section 4 of the constitution, I recognize Senator Redfield for a motion.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor. Members of the body, I move that a committee of three be appointed to escort the Secretary of State to the Chamber to deliver the election returns of the General Election of November 2002.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Redfield. The question is the adoption of the motion to appoint a committee to escort the Secretary of State. All those in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The motion is adopted and I appoint the following three senators to escort the Secretary of State to deliver the election returns. Those senators are Senator Connealy, Senator McDonald, and Senator Raikes. Would you please retire to the rear of the Chamber. The Chair would recognize the Sergeant at Arms.

SERGEANT AT ARMS: Mr. President, your committee now escorting the Secretary of State, John Gale.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: (Gavel) The Chair would recognize the Secretary of State.

SECRETARY OF STATE GALE: Mr. Clerk, I deliver to you the abstracts of the 2002 General Election from the 93 counties in Nebraska, for canvass by the members of the Ninety-Eighth Nebraska Legislature. (Legislative Journal pages 14-16.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Mr. Secretary of State. Would the committee please escort the Secretary of State to the rear of the Chamber. The Chair would recognize Senator Thompson for a motion.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, I move to approve the report of the Secretary of State, and the candidates stated therein be declared duly elected.
