SPEAKER BROMM: Members, are there any questions or persons that wish to speak on the amendment to the amendment described by Senator Hudkins, Chair of the Rules Committee? Seeing none, Senator Hudkins, do you wish to close on that amendment to the amendment?

SENATOR HUDKINS: Yes, I would close just by repeating what I said before. We are deleting language that pertains to the 2001 redistricting.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. Members, the question before us is whether or not to adopt the proposed amendment to the amendment, as described by Senator Hudkins, to the rules. All in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment to the amendment is adopted. The next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to amendment number one, as found in your Journal on page 84, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Is there any further debate on amendment number one, as found in the Journal as described by the Clerk? Senator Hudkins, do you wish to close on this amendment, as amended? Senator Hudkins waives closing. Members, the question before us is the adoption of amendment number one, as amended, to the permanent rules. All in favor signify by saying aye...or by voting aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of rules amendment number one, as offered by the Rules Committee.

SPEAKER BROMM: Amendment number one, as amended, is adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.
