Committee...so that caucus will be the same as the Committee on Committees. And I would appreciate your support on this proposal. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. You've heard the closing. The question before us is the adoption of rules proposal number three, as amended. Those in favor please signify by voting aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Rules Committee amendment number three.

SPEAKER BROMM: The proposal is adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next proposal is by the Rules Committee, amendment number four, found on Journal page 86.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Hudkins.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Mr. President and members. The number four committee proposal has to do with special session rules, and special session is addressed in Rule 9. What we are attempting to do is to make the rules regarding special session more similar to those that we follow in the regular session. In the first paragraph, we have taken out the language that says a motion to raise a bill that has been indefinitely postponed by a committee...that motion to raise shall take precedence in order of all other motions, except a motion to adjourn. The language that we have added is that the motion to raise must be disposed of by the Legislature within three legislative days. And then the second part of that, the resolution part, that action must be taken within two...and we've added the word "legislative" days. Before, the word "legislative" was not there, so you could strictly read that by...over the weekend is two days, and that was not the intent. So we have added that one word to make it a little more easy to understand and so we know exactly what the time limits are. So that, essentially, is what this particular proposal does. It just makes the rules for special session more closely follow those that we use in regular session. I will attempt to answer any questions. Otherwise,
