SENATOR CUDABACK: I do not. Whether...

SENATOR MAXWELL: Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Just can't find him. It's that simple. (Laughter) Don't know how else to put it.

SENATOR MAXWELL: Could we wait maybe 30 more seconds, and...

SENATOR CUDABACK: We may.

SENATOR MAXWELL: ...if not, we'll proceed. Yeah.
