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SENATOR TYSON: Senator Chambers, you have the body of the amendment in front of you?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I can get it.

SENATOR TYSON: Well, it's right there next to your...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now I have it...

SENATOR TYSON: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...in front of me.

SENATOR TYSON: Referring...this is kind of...this may be a...you have a chance to educate me on this because I'm ignorant in this regard. If you'll...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That is the first step toward wisdom. He who knows not and knows that he knows not is teachable; teach him.

SENATOR TYSON: Well, I just would tell the body that here it is, the fourth day of the session, and I'm already finding myself agreeing with Senator Chambers on this matter, and that concerns me highly and makes my judgment suspect. But, Senator Chambers, if you'd refer to the second sentence in the body of the rule which says, "The Reference Committee shall review each bill and resolution and either refer the matter to the appropriate committee or to General File."

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Which rule are you...I thought you said the body of Senator Schimek's amendment. Okay, I'm with you.

SENATOR TYSON: The second...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, second sentence.

SENATOR TYSON: ...sentence in the paragraph.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, I'm with you.

SENATOR TYSON: Not in just...
