SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, I wouldn't use that kind of language, so if you could...

SENATOR TYSON: Darn please?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...the question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Although that's not what her amendment addresses at this point, but we could do that under this language.
