ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President. (Read LB 515-523 by title for the first time, Legislative Journal pages 206-208.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 524-526 by title for the first time, Legislative Journal page 208.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President. (Read LB 527-528 by title for the first time.) I might indicate, Mr. President, while we're waiting for the last couple of bills, that Reference Committee will meet upon adjournment; Reference Committee, upon adjournment in Room 2102; Reference Committee, upon adjournment, 2102. (Read LB 529-533 by title for the first time.) In addition, Mr. President, a new constitutional amendment: LR 19CA by Senator Schimek would propose an amendment to Article VI, Section 2, of the Nebraska Constitution. Hearing notices from Education and the Agriculture Committees. I have the report of registered lobbyists for this week, Mr. President, to be inserted. And, finally, Senator, a series of add-name requests: Senator Combs to LB 460; Senator Combs to LB 432; Senator Price, LB 300 and LB 274 and LB 273 and LB 272 and LB 275 and LB 276. A reminder, Mr. President, Reference will meet upon adjournment. That's all that I have. (Legislative Journal pages 209-212.)
