January 22, 2003 LB 7, 8, 9

Senator Cudaback? Any other members wishing to address LB 7? Senator Cudaback waives closing. Members, we'll proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 7. Those wishing to support the advancement please vote aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 7.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 7 is advanced. Next bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 8, introduced by Senator Engel, as Chairperson of the Executive Board. (Read title.) Introduced on January 9, referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Cudaback, to open on LB 8.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker, members, if you heard the Clerk, as I know you all did, it's in the title itself. The year 2000 is gone, so this just simply does what the title says.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Anyone wishing to speak on LB 8? Seeing none, Senator Cudaback waives closing. Proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 8. All those in favor signify by voting aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 8.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 8 advances. LB 9, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 9 was a bill introduced by Senator Engel, as Chairperson of the Executive Board. (Read title.) Introduced on January 9 this year, referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker, members, this is a little bit
