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be pulled on the highway. Is that...that would...

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I think that's a fair characterization. Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...that's the committee's prerogative? Okay.

SENATOR BAKER: Although I wouldn't anticipate...well, that would be a whole new discussion, triple trailers.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, it wouldn't be a new discussion, because the law says they can do it.

SENATOR BAKER: Not in Nebraska. Not triple trailers.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Oh, yeah, it would be a new discussion on allowing triple trailers. But once there were triple trailers, they could tow them...

SENATOR BAKER: That's correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...under this bill.

SENATOR BAKER: That's correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The...and these things can be towed in good weather and in bad weather, I assume. You've got to go get them off the highway. So if it's sleet and rain and snow and that sort of thing, they can still be towed, right, under the bill?

SENATOR BAKER: That's correct. That was discussed,...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR BAKER: ...the safety hazards involved.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Senator Baker, thank you very much. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.
