that, so that they could...

SENATOR KREMER: That's the second part of it, that if it's after the quarterly report comes out, then they...they're required to give written notice that there's a lien filed. And if they have not done that, then that's their problem.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. So they do have a way to protect themselves.

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, by giving written notice. Then they come under that same statute...

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay.

SENATOR KREMER: ...that they have to then write a two-party check, and upon their endorsement of it, that relieves the...that gives the waiver of it, then, too.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. Thank you, Senator Kremer. And thank you, Mr. Speaker.
