ages of children required to be included in reports to Department of Education. This does not affect programs being offered. This is simply a change in a reporting requirement, to make that reporting requirement more consistent with the information schools are able to get from hospitals and other institutions they have to deal with. I'll mention there are a number of things eliminated in the bill. It's listed out. One of those is a reimbursement for school district reorganization studies. I mention that one, because that one actually results in a fiscal note for this bill, which you may want to take a look at, and a savings of a little over \$18,000 per year. The reason for eliminating that provision was that it simply was not being used. So please take a look at the various provisions of this bill. If you have any questions, I'd be happy to try to address them. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. You've heard the opening on LB 67. There are committee amendments. Senator Raikes, Chairman of the Education Committee, you're recognized to open on the committee amendments to LB 67.

SENATOR RAIKES: Again, thank you, Mr. President and members. There is one item, a very technical committee amendment. There is...was a change proposed in the green copy in Section 79-10,110 that would change the hearing proceedings or hearing requirements, public hearing requirements, for a...let's see, I've forgotten now exactly what the title of it is, the qualified capital fund? I'll see if I can see that and give you a correct name of that. At any rate, this amendment would eliminate that change simply for the reason that the change does not accomplish what was intended to be accomplished. It was an effort to streamline the bill and, in so doing, it makes reference to a section which really doesn't relate to the public hearing requirement being discussed. So, again, this is a very technical change. It changes in the direction of not making the change that the department requested. You can look at it. It's on the bottom of page 31 in the green copy of the bill. So I urge your advancement of this technical amendment that is the committee amendment. Thank you.
