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SENATOR JENSEN: At this point, the fiscal note says it's neutral. Now the money that... the \$67,000, as you said, I really don't know. I would have to find out.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may continue, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR JENSEN: That was in there.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR JENSEN: One other thing I might mention, not only is the fees being adjusted, we had also termination dates anywhere from one to, on some, three years, two years, or whatever. We're also trying to bring those all in uniformity...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Uniformity. That's great.

SENATOR JENSEN: ...so that there won't be any more annual fees. They'll be...it'll be for two years or three years, one or the other.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And if you take in totality the amount of licensing fee reduction that's brought about by this bill, what would that come to? What are we talking about? Like I think the Cash Fund note for this department, which I think is almost exclusively licensing fee, is about \$3.7 million right now. Is that being reduced significantly or...?

SENATOR JENSEN: I really don't know, Senator Beutler...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Not sure, okay.

SENATOR JENSEN: ...what that amount is. We can find out for you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. The last thing I wanted to ask you about, the well drillers seem to be treated differently in the bill. They are not subject, as I understand it, to the general provisions of 24 through 26 which provide for the costing system that is to apply to everybody else. Why are they separate and apart from everybody else who's regulated?
