SENATOR JENSEN: No.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Chambers, on advancement of LB 245.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Schimek is ahead of me. She is trying to digest the bill. I haven't even been able to chew it up yet, so I'm going to try to get a little help from Senator Jensen, if I can. Senator Jensen, do you have a copy of your bill in front of you?

SENATOR JENSEN: I do.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you respond?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you turn to page 19, in line 21? Tell me if you're with me.

SENATOR JENSEN: I'm with you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What is chlorotestosterone? Does that have anything to do with VIAGRA, if you know, before anybody laughs?

SENATOR JENSEN: I do not know. Testosterone I do know a little bit about, but chlorotestosterone I know nothing about.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Beutler over here messed up what I was going to say, so I'm not going to say it on the mike. It was clean, because we are talking in a sense about chlorine or things like that that you put in the water. But, Senator Jensen, there are a lot of things in this bill you would agree because you've highlighted many of them. On page 2 of the white sheet that is a part of your committee statement, do you see midway down the page where it says Sections 23 to 30; outline new fee provisions? Section 23 provides intent that the cost of the credentialing system administered by the department be paid from General Funds, Cash Funds, federal funds, and so forth.
