SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...on behalf of my rural colleagues. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: I see no further speakers. Senator Stuhr, you're recognized to close on the advancement.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. This LB 92 proposes to strike this statute that refers to the Rural Development Commission. It will allow them to become a nonprofit entity, and also allow them then to have an open membership structure. And they will thence be eligible for some federal funding. I believe that this move will also enable them to carry on the work that they have been doing in rural development across the state. And with that, I ask for your support. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. You've heard the closing. The question, members, is the advancement of LB 92 to E & R Initial. All in favor please vote aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 92.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 92 does advance. Move on to LB 306, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 306, a bill introduced by Senator Stuhr. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 13 of this year, at that time referred to the Natural Resources Committee. The bill was advanced to General File.
