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question. I don't want to be quoting people when the person is here.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Stuhr.

SENATOR STUHR: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Stuhr, did you tell us that there is no intent at this time to raise any of these fees, increase any of these fees?

SENATOR STUHR: That is correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: When do they intend to increase these fees?

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR STUHR: I am not sure. I do know that in the one handout that you all received, there have been only four changes in the last ten years. And so...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So we don't really need this bill...

SENATOR STUHR: ...they have not...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...we don't really need this bill today, do we?

SENATOR STUHR: Well, I believe that we do. And...because of many of the services that are provided by our Game and Parks division, there are many new areas that they now have to look after, such as disease control. We have the chronic wasting disease in our deer and our wild game. We have West Nile, that has certainly attacked many horses within the state. They are responsible for that area. And the cost of inflation. I'm constantly hearing from my constituents...

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.
